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## **Perpetual Calendar Instructions**

Never forget a birthday again! The Perpetual Birthday Calendar Project Kit #137950 will not only help you keep track of birthdays, it will look oh-so-beautiful doing it. Coordinates with Perpetual Calendar stamp set #137167. Stamps, inks, and adhesives sold separately.

### **Here is what you get:**

~Printed calendar sheets *Choose the correct number of days for each month. I have marked them.*

~Adhesive letters

~Die Cuts:

*Banners: Pink Mosaic, Pink Chevron, Yellow Mosaic, Yellow Chevron, Lost Lagoon Mosaic, Lost Lagoon Chevron*

*Stars: Lost Lagoon, Yellow, Red*

*Hearts: Red, Pink, Melon Mambo*

*Feathers: Lost Lagoon, Red, Pink.*

~Printed card stock sticker for front of box

~(4) Die cut Gold Glimmer Paper banners

~Confetti stickers *1 sheet each: Yellow Stars, Red Stars, Pink Hearts, Red Hearts*

~Clipboard

~Gold Binder Clip

~Lost Lagoon 3/8" Satin Stitched Ribbon

~Blushing Bride Thick Baker's Twine

~Gold Metallic Baker's Twine

~Gold Sequin Trim

~Sequins

~Gold Glitter

~Sponge

~Kraft Box

**Coordinating Colors:** Baked Brown Sugar (Light Brown), Blushing Bride (*Pink*), Hello Honey (*Yellow*), Lost Lagoon, Melon Mambo, Real Red

### **Tips:**

~Before you start, make sure your card has the correct number of lines for the month you want.

~Each card is printed with lines

*28 for February*

*30 for January, April, June, September, November*

*31 for March, May, July, August, October, December*

~Want to add extra layers of color? Use the stamping off technique or sponge daubers to add extra color where you want it.

~If you want to give the calendar as a gift, decorate the box with the Lost Lagoon Ribbon and the Perpetual Birthday Calendar sticker. Packaging done!

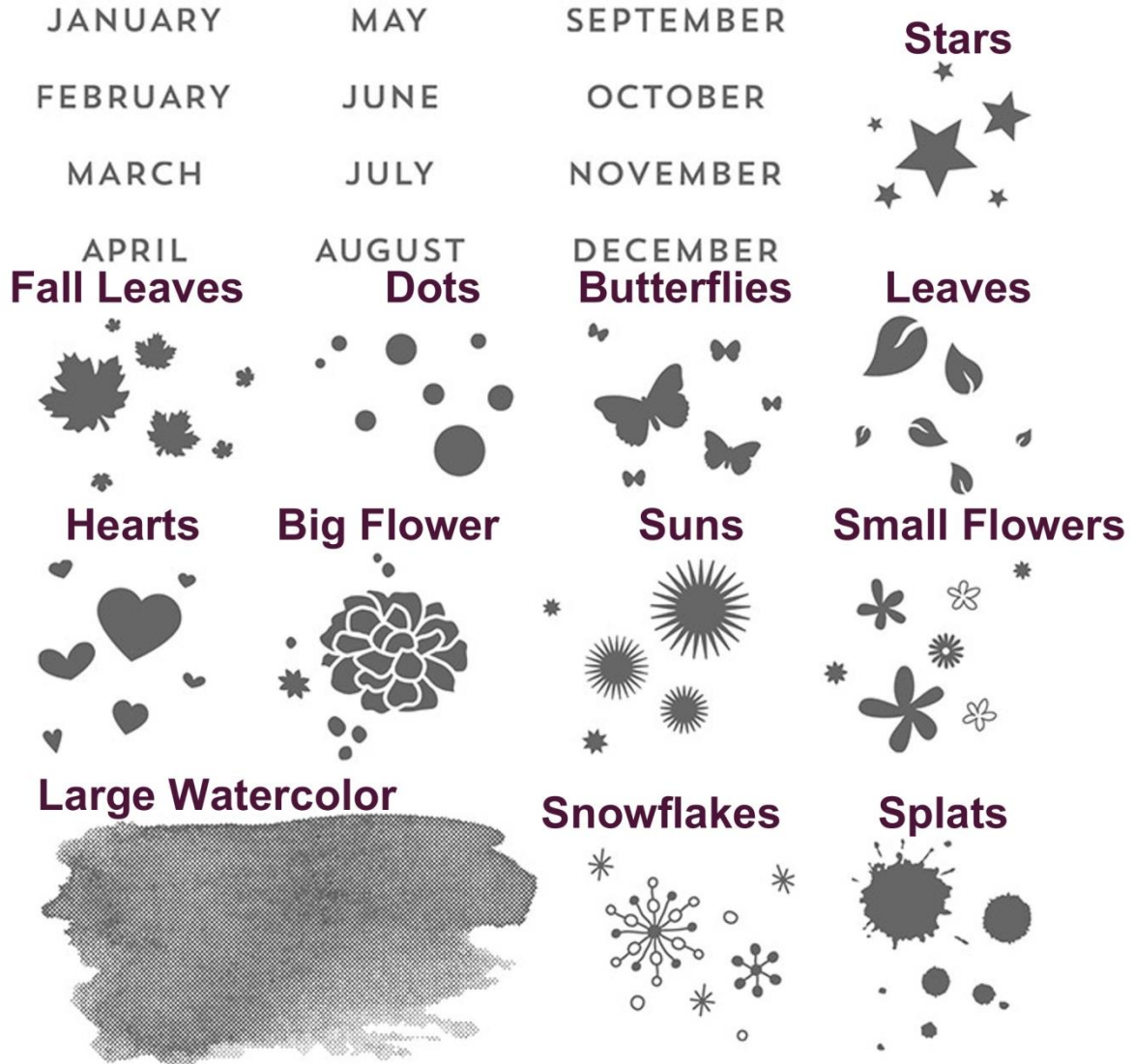
### **It's as easy as 1-2-3:**

1. Stamp a background and month.
2. Add accents and twine.
3. Clip to board

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**Stamp Set.** *I have put what I named each stamp above the image in Purple. Images are shown larger than the actual stamp set.*



# Perpetual Calendar Instructions

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## ***Instruction Numbers:***

You can design your Calendar cards however you want, but here are some ideas to get you started:

1. Stamp background and layer shape and letter.
2. Wrap Baker's Twine around the backing board several times and tie in front.
3. Create confetti look by layering background stamp and small stickers.
4. Adhere Sequins with a drop of Multipurpose Liquid Glue. (*I used Glue Dots instead of Tombow Glue.*)
5. Stamp background in multiple colors to create dimension.
6. Adhere Glimmer Paper Banner with Multipurpose Liquid Glue. (*I used Fast Fuse*)
7. Place a drop of glue on the card and cover with glitter.
8. Clip sequin trim for added sparkle.
9. *Use a Marker to edge the Die Cut and/or Letter.*
10. *A Sponge is included for you to use in sponging the letters and die cut edges if you want to. I totally forgot to use it.*

## **General Instructions:**

**The Month Name** is listed.

**30 days** = the number of days in the month. Choose the sheet from the kit with that number of days.

These are some general instructions to use on your page.

**Month Letter** = the first letter of the month. These are on self-adhesive sheets. If you want them to be a solid color you can color them with a Marker while still attached to the sheet. I colored the edges of most of mine with a Marker.

**Die Cut:** Banners and other shapes you can decorate your pages with. You will have some left over for other projects.

**Stamps:** I have named the stamps on the picture on page 2. It is best to have the Stampin' Pierce Mat (without piercing holes) under your card stock when stamping to get a better image when you stamp with Photopolymer stamps.

**Ink Colors:** These are the colors I used. You can choose different colors if you want or if you don't have the ones listed. I just like a variety of colors.

**Other:** Other supplies and embellishments used. There are embellishments and supplies included in the kit that I didn't use. Feel free to use them either on your calendar project or in other projects.

## **BASIC INSTRUCTIONS AND TIPS:**

1. Position the die cut(s) about where you want them. This will help you determine where to stamp your Month Name and other images. You will usually want some images under the Banner/Die Cut. I usually stamped the images, attached the Banner/Die Cut, and then stamped the month.
2. Remember to stamp your image in the lower right corner. I forgot on a page or two.
3. Banners & Die Cuts. If desired you can use a Marker or part of the sponge included in the kit to add color to the edges of your Banners and Die Cuts. I attached these with Tombow Glue or Fast Fuse.

## Perpetual Calendar Instructions

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### Whole Calendar with all sheets.

Make clip board with the striped Kraft cardboard piece, the large metal clip, and wrap the Gold Baker's twine around the clipboard three times and tie a bow. You can also attach the Gold Sequin Trim along one edge if desired.

You can leave all the sheets in the clipboard OR store the sheets for the other months in the box they came in.

After having mine in the clipboard for a couple of months I would recommend that you store some in the box as it indents the upper pages and the adhesive letters start coming off because of the pressure.



## Perpetual Calendar Instructions

### January. 30 days

Instructions #s: 1,2 5, 9

Month Letter: J

Due Cut: Lost Lagoon Banner

Stamps: Snowflake, Splat

Ink Colors: Soft Sky,

Lost Lagoon

Other: Lost Lagoon Marker

### General Directions

1. Choose the sheet with 30 days on it.
2. Lay the Banner in the desired position. This will give you an idea of where to stamp. You do want some stamped images under the Banner.
3. Stamp the Snowflakes in Lost Lagoon and the Splats in Soft Sky. Remember to stamp in the lower right corner.
4. Banners & Die Cuts. Color the edges with a Marker or sponging if you want the edges to stand out more. I attached them with Tombow Glue or Fast Fuse.
5. Stamp January in Lost Lagoon ink.
6. Edge the J with the Lost Lagoon Marker.

### February. 28 days

Instructions #s: 1,2 3, 4, 5

Month Letter: F

Die Cuts: Pink and Red  
Hearts

Stamp: Hearts

Ink Colors: Real Red

Other: Heart stickers,  
Sequins, Glue Dots

1. Lay Hearts in the desired position.
2. Stamp Hearts in Real Red ink under the die cut Hearts. Remember to stamp in the lower right corner.
3. Attach large Hearts.
4. Stamp February in Real Red ink.
5. Edge the F with your Real Red Marker. Attach.
6. Attach the Red and Pink Heart Stickers above the Large Hearts.
7. Attach Sequins with Glue Dots.

### March. 31 days

Instructions #s: 1, 2, 5, 7, 9

Month Letter: M

Due Cut: Yellow Chevron  
Banner

Stamp: Dots

Ink Colors: Garden Green,  
Wild Wasabi,  
Pistachio Pudding

Other: Glitter, Tombow Glue

1. Lay your Banner in the desired position.
2. Edge your Banner with a line of Tombow Glue. Cover with Glitter. Let dry.
3. Stamp the Dots using the various colors of ink. Remember to stamp the lower right corner too.
4. Color the M with your Garden Green Marker before removing it from the sheet.
5. Attach Banner with Tombow Glue after it has dried.
6. Attach M.

### April. 30 days

Instructions #s: 1, 2, 9

Month Letter: A

Due Cut: Pink Mosaic Banner

Stamp: Butterflies

Ink Color: Blackberry Bliss ink  
pad and marker

Other: none

1. Lay your Banner in the desired position.
2. Stamp your Butterflies in Blackberry Bliss including the lower right corner.
3. Stamp April in Blackberry Bliss.
4. Edge your Banner if desired. Attach.
5. Edge your A with the Blackberry Bliss Marker. Attach.



## Perpetual Calendar Instructions



### May. 31 days

Instructions #s: 1, 2, 5, 6, 7, 9

Month Letter: M

Die Cut: Glimmer Banner

Stamp: Small Flowers

Ink Color: Tempting Turquoise,  
Coastal Cabana

Other: Tempting Turquoise  
Marker, Glitter, Tombow Glue

1. Lay Banner in desired position.
2. Stamp your Small Flowers in Coastal Cabana and Tempting Turquoise inks.
3. Attach Banner with Tombow Glue.
4. Edge you M with the Tempting Turquoise Marker and attach.
5. Use a dot of Tombow Glue in the center of some of the Flowers. Put Glitter on the Glue. Let dry.

## Perpetual Calendar Instructions

### June. 30 days

Instructions #s: 1, 2, 7

Month Letter: J

Due Cut: Lost Lagoon

Chevron Banner

Stamp: Suns

Ink Color: Daffodil Delight

Other: Glitter, Tombow Glue

1. Lay your Banner in the desired position.
2. Stamp your Suns in Daffodil Delight include the lower right corner.
3. Stamp June in Lost Lagoon ink.
4. Edge your Banner if desired and attach.
5. Put your J on a Clear Mount Block. Put Tombow Glue on the top and cover with Glitter. Attach over Banner when dry.

## July. 31 days

Instructions #s: 1, 2, 5

Month Letter: J

Due Cut: Red Star

Stamp: Stars

Ink Color: Real Red,  
Night of Navy

Other: none

1. Lay Star in desired position.
2. Stamp your Stars in Real Red and Night of Navy inks including in the lower right corner.
3. Stamp July in Real Red ink.
4. Attach your Star and the J.

## Perpetual Calendar Instructions



### August. 31 days

Instructions #s: 1, 2, 9

Month Letter: A

Die Cut: Pink Chevron Banner

Stamp: Big Flower

Ink Color: Wisteria Wonder

Other: Elegant Eggplant  
Marker

1. Lay pieces in desired positions.
2. Stamp Big Flowers in Wisteria Wonder ink on the top and in the lower right corner.
3. Stamp August in Wisteria Wonder.
4. Edge your Banner with a Marker or Sponge if desired. I didn't. Attach with Tombow Glue.
5. Edge your A with the Elegant Eggplant Marker and attach.

## Perpetual Calendar Instructions



### September. 30 days

Instructions #s: 1, 2, 9

Month Letter: S

Due Cut: Yellow Mosaic  
Banner

Stamp: Leaves

Ink Color: Crushed Curry,  
Garden Green

Other: Tangerine Tango  
Marker

1. Color the edges of your Banner with either a Marker or Sponge. I used the Tangerine Tango Marker.
2. Lay all the pieces in the desired positions.
3. Stamp your Leaves in Crushed Curry ink where desired on the top around your Banner and in the lower right corner.
4. Stamp September in Garden Green ink.
5. Attach Banner with Tombow Glue.
6. Edge your S with the Tangerine Tango Marker and attach on top of Banner.

## Perpetual Calendar Instructions

### October. 31 days

Instructions #s: 1, 2, 5, 6

Month Letter: O

Due Cut: Glimmer Banner

Stamps: Dots, Splats

Ink Colors: Memento Black,  
Tangerine Tango

Other: Color whole letter with  
Tangerine Tango Marker

1. Lay out the pieces in the desired positions.
2. Stamp the Splats with Tangerine Tango ink. Stamp the Dots with Black ink. Stamp in the lower right corner if desired. I forgot. I guess I still need to do that.
3. Stamp October in Black ink.
4. Glue on your Banner with Tombow Glue.
5. Color your O with your Tangerine Tango Marker BEFORE you remove it from the sheet. Attach it over Banner.



## Perpetual Calendar Instructions



### November. 30 days

Instructions #s: 1, 2, 9

Month Letter: N

Due Cut: Pink & Blue Feathers

Stamp: Fall Leaves

Ink Color: Cherry Cobbler,

Tangerine Tango

Other: Cherry Cobbler Marker  
to color the edge of the N

1. Lay out Feathers in the desired position. Attach with Glue Dots or Tombow Glue.
2. Stamp Leaves in Cherry Cobbler ink twice on each side of the feathers, rotating the stamp to get a more random look. Also stamp in the lower right corner.
3. Stamp November in Tangerine Tango ink.
4. Edge the N with Cherry Cobbler Marker and attach over Feathers.

### December. 31 days

Instructions #s: 1, 2, 3, 6, 7

Month Letter: D

Die Cuts: Yellow Star,  
2 Glimmer Banners

Stamp: Stars

Ink Color: Daffodil Delight,  
Real Red

Other: Glitter, Tombow Glue  
Yellow Star Stickers

1. Lay out items in desired positions.
2. Use Tombow Glue around the edge of the Star die cut and cover with Glitter. Let dry before attaching.
3. Stamp stars with Daffodil Delight ink in both top corners and the lower right corner.
4. Stamp December with Real Red ink.
5. Put small Star Stickers on Glimmer Banners. Attach Banners with Tombow Glue.
6. Edge the D with the Cherry Cobbler Marker.
7. Carefully attach the Star with Glitter edges with Tombow Glue.
8. Attach the D over the large Star after the Glitter is dry.
